Short Title: Court Sys. Study/Amend DV Empowerment Act. (Public) Sponsors: Referred to: February 21, 2005 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO DIRECT THE NORTH CAROLINA COURTS COMMISSION TO STUDY THE ORGANIZATION OF THE GENERAL COURT OF JUSTICE INTO DISTRICTS AND DIVISIONS AND TO AMEND THE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE VICTIMS EMPOWERMENT ACT. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** The North Carolina Courts Commission shall study the current state of the General Court of Justice, focusing on workloads, case backlogs, and other issues relevant to the efficient administration of justice and determine whether the current organization of the State into judicial divisions, superior court districts, district court districts, and prosecutorial districts is in need of revision or adjustment in order to better serve the interests of justice. The Commission shall report its findings and recommendations to the 2006 Regular Session of the 2005 General Assembly. **SECTION 2.(a)** Section 2 of S.L. 2005-343 is repealed. **SECTION 2.(b)** Section 3 of S.L. 2005-343 reads as rewritten: "SECTION 3. The Administrative Office of the Courts shall—may develop a standard informational sheet for plaintiffs issued protective orders under Chapter 50B of the General Statutes that explains the plaintiffs' right to apply for a permit under
