A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO DIVIDE SUPERIOR COURT DISTRICT 13.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-41(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) The counties of the State are organized into judicial divisions and superior court districts, and each superior court district has the counties, and the number of regular resident superior court judges set forth in the following table, and for districts of less than a whole county, as set out in subsection (b) of this section:

4 **SECTION 2.** The superior court judgeship established for District 13A by
5 Section 1 of this act shall be filled by the judge currently serving District 13 who resides
6 in Bladen or Columbus County, who shall serve until the expiration of that judge's
7 current term.

8 **SECTION 3.** The superior court judgeship established for District 13B by
9 Section 1 of this act shall be filled by the judge currently serving District 13 who resides
10 in Brunswick County, who shall serve until the expiration of that judge's current term.

11 **SECTION 4.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
12 Department the sum of forty-seven thousand six hundred eight dollars (\$47,608) for the
13 2006-2007 fiscal year to upgrade one superior court judge to senior resident superior
14 court judge and provide the necessary support staff.

15 **SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective January 1, 2007, or the date upon
16 which Section 1 of this act is approved under section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of
17 1965, whichever is later.
