Short Title: Counties May Provide Funds to Charter Schools. (Public) Sponsors: Senators Goodall; Berger of Franklin, Horton, Jacumin, Pittenger, and Webster. Referred to: Education/Higher Education. February 24, 2005 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT AUTHORIZING COUNTIES TO PROVIDE FUNDS TO CHARTER SCHOOLS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 153A-149(c) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: "(c) Each county may levy property taxes for one or more of the purposes listed in this subsection up to a combined rate of one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) on the one hundred dollars (\$100.00) appraised value of property subject to taxation. Authorized purposes subject to the rate limitation are: <u>Charter Schools. – To provide funds to charter schools located within</u> (9a) the county for the operations or capital expenses of the charter schools." **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
