SECTION 1. Article 36 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is	is amended by
adding a new section to read:	•
"§ 14-280.2. Use of a laser device towards an aircraft.	
(a) Any person who, willfully points a laser device at an aircr	aft, while the
device is emitting a laser beam, and while the aircraft is taking off, landing	g, in flight, or
otherwise in motion, is guilty of a Class H felony.	
(b) The following definitions apply to this section:	
(1) "Aircraft" is as defined in G.S. 63-1.	
(2) "Laser" is as defined in G.S. 14-34.8."	
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2005,	and applies to
offenses committed on or after that date.
