5	SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-304(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to
6	read:
7	"(8) For the services of any municipal police laboratory facility, the district
8	or superior court judge shall, upon conviction, order payment of the
9	sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) to be remitted to the general
10	fund of the laboratory's municipality to be used for law enforcement
11	purposes. The cost shall be assessed only in cases in which, as part of
12	the investigation leading to the defendant's conviction, the municipal
13	laboratory has performed DNA analysis of the crime, test of bodily
14	fluids of the defendant for the presence of alcohol or controlled
15	substances, or analysis of any controlled substance possessed by the
16	defendant or the defendant's agent. The court may waive or reduce the
17	amount of the payment required by this subdivision upon a finding of
18	just cause to grant such a waiver or reduction."
19	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005, and applies to court
20	costs assessed or collected on or after that date.
