SESSION LAW 2005-251 SENATE BILL 593

AN ACT TO EXEMPT ATTORNEYS APPOINTED TO REPRESENT INDIGENT CLIENTS FROM THE FEE CHARGED BY THE CLERK OF COURT FOR PREPARING COPIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-308 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(b1) The fees set forth in subdivision (12) of subsection (a) of this section are not chargeable when copies are requested by an attorney who has been appointed to represent an indigent person at State expense, if the request is made in connection with the appointed case and during the duration of the appointment."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005, and applies to fees

charged on or after that date.
