March 17, 2005 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE LONG-TERM VOCATIONAL SUPPORT SERVICES TO PERSONS WITH MENTAL **ILLNESS** AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Whereas, persons with mental illness and developmental disabilities should have the dignity and responsibility conferred by work; and Whereas, the General Assembly has legislated that best practice will be the standard for reform of the mental health system; and Whereas, long-term vocational support services are recognized as a best practice for persons with severe disabilities; Now, therefore, **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services the sum of six million dollars (\$6,000,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of six million dollars (\$6,000,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to provide long-term vocational

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
