A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE STATE HIGHWAY PATROL 3 AIRCRAFT OPERATIONS. Whereas, the current aircraft used by the State Highway Patrol are military 4 5 surplus aircraft over 30 years old and are not capable of meeting the mission requirements that are imposed on the Aircraft Operations Section of the State Highway 6 7 Patrol: and 8 Whereas, in recent years the State has been heavily impacted by hurricanes, 9 floods, and other natural disasters and several people have lost their lives as a result of 10 these natural disasters: and 11 Whereas, the purchase of new aircraft for the State Highway Patrol would allow the Aircraft Operations Section of the State Highway Patrol to rescue more people 12 during natural disasters, to carry personnel, equipment, and supplies to areas of the State 13 14 impacted by natural disaster, and to respond more quickly and efficiently to the needs of the citizens of the State during a natural disaster or when a person is missing; and 15 Whereas, the lives of the State Highway Patrol pilots are at risk by operating 16 aircraft that is over 30 years old; Now, therefore, 17 18 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Of the funds available to the Department of Crime Control and 19 Public Safety for the 2005-2007 biennium for the Highway Patrol, the Department shall 20 use the sum of six million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$6,700,000) for the 21 22 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for aircraft operations for the State Highway Patrol. The funds 23 shall be used to purchase four new aircraft, to hire 24 sworn personnel and six nonsworn 24 25 personnel, and to provide services, training, equipment, and supplies, including aviation fuel and aircraft parts, for the aircraft operations of the State Highway Patrol. 26 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005. 27
