2 extended family. The list shall include only those things received
3 during the 12 months preceding the reporting period under subsection
4 (d) of this section, and shall include the source of those things. The list
5 required by this subdivision shall not apply to things of monetary
6 value received by the filing person prior to the time the person filed or
7 was nominated as a candidate for office, as described in G.S. 138A-22,
8 or was appointed or employed as a covered person."

9 **SECTION 3.** G.S. 138A-38(1) reads as rewritten:

10 "(1) The only interest or reasonably foreseeable benefit that accrues to the
11 covered person, the covered person's extended family, nonprofit with
12 which the covered person is associated, or business with which the
13 covered person is associated as a member of a profession, occupation,
14 or general class is no greater than that which could reasonably be
15 foreseen to accrue to all members of that profession, occupation, or
16 general class."

17 **SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
