SESSION LAW 2008-159 HOUSE BILL 1230

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL ONE-TIME PERMITS TO NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 18B-1002(a)(2) reads as rewritten:

"(2) A permit may be issued to a nonprofit organization to allow the retail sale of malt beverages, unfortified wine, or <u>mixed</u> <u>beverages, or to allow brown-bagging, at a single fund-raising event of that organization. A permit for this purpose shall not be issued for the sale of any kind of alcoholic beverage in a jurisdiction where the sale of that alcoholic beverage is not lawful."</u>

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 18th day of July, 2008.
