"§ 20-17.3. Revocation for underage purchasers of alcohol.

offenses committed on or after that date.

1	The Division shall revoke for one year the driver's license of any person who has
2	been convicted of violating any of the following:
3	(1) G.S. 18B 302(c)(1),G.S. 18B-302(c), (e), or (f); or (f).
4	(2) G.S. 18B-302(b), if the violation occurred while the person was
5	purchasing or attempting to purchase an alcoholic beverage.
6	(3) G.S. 18B-302(a), except that this subdivision shall only apply if the
7	violation occurred while the person was giving an alcoholic beverage
8	to an underage person.
9	If the person's license is currently suspended or revoked, then the revocation under this
10	section shall begin at the termination of that revocation. A person whose license is
11	revoked under this section for a violation of G.S. 18B-302(a) or G.S. 18B-302(c) shall
12	be eligible for a limited driving privilege under G.S. 20-179.3."
