The home care agency shall 16 17 inform its clients that employees of the agency are prohibited from smoking in a client's 18 home. As used in this section: 19 'Employee' includes an individual under contract with the home care (1) 20 agency to provide home care services. 21 <u>(2)</u> 'Smoking' means the use or possession of any lighted cigar, cigarette, 22 pipe, or other lighted smoking product. 23 The Department may impose an administrative penalty not to exceed two (b) 24 hundred dollars (\$200.00) for each violation on any person who owns, manages, 25 operates, or otherwise controls the home care agency and fails to comply with this section." 26 27 **SECTION 5.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to 28 violations committed on and after that date. G.S. 131D-4.4(c)(3), 131E-114.3(b)(3),

and 122C-6(b)(3), as enacted by this act, apply to individuals admitted to the facility on

and after the effective date of this act.

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
