or proceeding for custody ex parte who has been convicted of a sexually	violent offense
as defined in G.S. 14-208.6(5) shall disclose the conviction in the pleading	ngs."
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective October 1, 2007,	, and applies to
actions or proceedings filed on or after that date.
