A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW EXISTING CHARTER SCHOOLS TO ELECT TO **PARTICIPATE** THE TEACHERS' **STATE** IN **AND EMPLOYEES'** COMPREHENSIVE MAJOR MEDICAL PLAN; AND TO ALLOW AN EXISTING CHARTER SCHOOL TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TEACHERS' AND STATE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND THE NORTH CAROLINA TEACHERS' AND **STATE** EMPLOYEES' COMPREHENSIVE **MAJOR** MEDICAL PLAN.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

10 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding the time limitations contained in G.S. 135-5.3 11 and G.S. 135-40.3A, the Board of Directors of Orange Charter School, a charter school located in Hillsborough, may elect to become a participating employer in the Teachers' 12 13 and State Employees' Retirement System in accordance with Article 1 of Chapter 135 of the General Statutes and may also elect to become a participating employing unit in the 14 15 North Carolina Teachers' and State Employees' Comprehensive Major Medical Plan in accordance with Article 3 of Chapter 135 of the General Statutes. Notwithstanding the 16 time limitations contained in G.S. 135-40.3A, the Board of Directors of Bethany 17 Community Middle School, a charter school in Rockingham County, may elect to 18 become a participating employing unit in the North Carolina Teachers' and State 19 20 Employees' Comprehensive Major Medical Plan in accordance with Article 3 of Chapter 135 of the General Statutes. Notwithstanding the time limitations contained in 21 G.S. 135-40.3A, the board of directors of Tiller School, a charter school, may elect to 22 23 become a participating employing unit in the North Carolina Teachers' and State Employees' Comprehensive Major Medical Plan in accordance with Article 3 of 24 Chapter 135 of the General Statutes. The election authorized by this section shall be 25 made no later than 30 days after the effective date of this act and shall be made in 26 accordance with all other requirements of G.S. 135-40.3A. The elections authorized by 27 28 this section shall be made no later than 30 days after the effective date of this act and

- 1 shall be made in accordance with all other requirements of G.S. 135-40.3A and, as
- 2 applicable, with G.S. 135-5.3.
- 3 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
