The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 115C-107.7 reads as rewritten:	
"§ 115C-107.7. Discipline. Discipline and homebound instruction.	
(a) The policies and procedures for the discipline of students with d	lisabilities
shall be consistent with federal laws and regulations.	
(b) If a change of placement occurs under the discipline regulations of	
local educational agency shall not assign a student to homebound instruction

homebound instruction is the least restrictive alternative environment for the

<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
