7	The General	Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
8	SECTION 1. The Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina		
9	shall study the accessibility of its facilities to severely physically disabled individuals		
10	seeking basic access to higher education at constituent institutions within the State		
11	University System. In its study, the Board of Governors may consider all of the		
12	following:		
13	(1)) What specific educational assistance the State has funded that would	
14		be available to severely physically disabled individuals.	
15	(2)) What specific educational assistance the State currently funds that	
16		would be available to severely physically disabled individuals.	
17	(3)) The role of the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation of the	
18		Department of Health and Human Services in providing educational	
19		assistance at public and private universities or secondary schools that	
20		was, or currently is, available to severely physically disabled	
21		individuals.	
22	(4)) Whether the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation of the Department	
23		of Health and Human Services could provide for the personal care of	
24		severely physically disabled students at one or more constituent	
25		institutions within the State University System.	
26	(5)) The desirability and feasibility of making the facilities of one	
27		constituent institution accessible to severely physically disabled	
28		students.	

1	(6)	The estimated costs of making the facilities of one constituent
2		institution accessible to severely physically disabled students and
3		providing for the personal care of severely physically disabled students
4		at this institution.
5	(7)	Whether the Illinois program to support its physically disabled
6		population at its state universities offers any guidance to North
7		Carolina.
8	(8)	Any other issues the Board of Governors deems pertinent to its study
9		under this section.
10	SECT	TION 2. No later than May 1, 2008, the Board of Governors of The
11	University of N	orth Carolina shall submit a report of its study to the Fiscal Research
12	Division and to	the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee, including its
13	findings, recom	nendations, and any legislative proposals.
14	SECT	TION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
