4	ORDINANCE THAT IS NOT PART OF A PUBLIC ENTERPRISE.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 153A-454(a) reads as rewritten:
7	"(a) A county may adopt and enforce a stormwater control ordinance to protect
8	water quality and control water quantity. A county may adopt a stormwater
9	management ordinance pursuant to this Chapter, other applicable laws, or any
10	combination of these powers. A county may establish and revise, in accordance with
11	G.S. 153A-277, from time to time, schedules of rates, fees, charges, and penalties for
12	the operation and enforcement of a stormwater control or a stormwater management
13	ordinance."
14	<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 160A-459(a) reads as rewritten:
15	"(a) A city may adopt and enforce a stormwater control ordinance to protect water
16	quality and control water quantity. A city may adopt a stormwater management
17	ordinance pursuant to this Chapter, its charter, other applicable laws, or any
18	combination of these powers. A city may establish and revise, in accordance with
19	G.S. 160A-314, from time to time, schedules of rates, fees, charges, and penalties for
20	the operation and enforcement of a stormwater control or a stormwater management
21	ordinance."
22	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
