A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ADD THE TOWN OF LOWELL TO AREAS LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES MAY USE ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES ON HIGHWAYS WITH POSTED SPEED LIMITS OF THIRTY-FIVE MILES PER HOUR OR LESS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 3 of S.L. 2004-108, as rewritten by S.L. 2005-305, S.L. 2006-25, S.L. 2006-116, and S.L. 2007-4 reads as rewritten:

**"SECTION 3.** Section 1 of this act applies to the Towns of Beaufort, Highlands, Southern Shores, and Mint Hill only. Section 2 of this act applies to the Towns of Atlantic Beach, Burgaw, Carolina Beach, Cramerton, Dallas, Duck, Emerald Isle, Indian Beach, Kill Devil Hills, Kitty Hawk, Kure Beach, Lowell, Nags Head, Oakboro, Ocean Isle Beach, North Topsail Beach, Pine Knoll Shores, Stanley, Surf City, Topsail Beach, and Wrightsville Beach, the Cities of Albemarle, Belmont, Cherryville, Gastonia, Kings Mountain, Mount Holly, and Rockingham and the Counties of Cleveland, Currituck, Gaston, Surry, and Wilkes only. The term 'municipal employee' shall include employees of a county."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
