May 20, 2008 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION TO 3 **DEVELOP** AND **IMPLEMENT APPROPRIATE GRADE-LEVEL** 4 CURRICULUM MATERIALS ON THE 1898 WILMINGTON RACE RIOT. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 **SECTION 1.** Article 8 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended 7 by adding a new section to read: 8 "§ 115C-81.3. Curriculum on 1898 Wilmington Race Riot. 9 The State Board of Education shall develop and implement curriculum learning experiences on the 1898 Wilmington Race Riot, developing appropriate grade-level 10 curriculum materials, and provide teacher workshops for effectively integrating the 11 12 materials into instruction." 13 SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of one hundred ninety-nine thousand dollars

(\$199,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to implement the provisions of this act.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
