A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR PUBLIC AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS
3 AND COMMUNICATIONS STRATEGIES ON STROKE SIGNS AND
4 SYMPTOMS, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JUSTUS-WARREN HEART
5 DISEASE AND STROKE PREVENTION TASK FORCE.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
8 Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of three
9 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds
10 shall be used to develop and implement public awareness campaigns and
11 communications strategies on signs and symptoms of stroke.

12 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
