A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO EXEMPT BUSES FROM SAFETY INSPECTIONS REQUIRED  
2 UNDER MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS IF THEY ARE TITLED TO A LOCAL  
3 EDUCATION AGENCY AND SUBJECT TO SCHOOL BUS INSPECTION  
4 REQUIREMENTS, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE  
5 TRANSPORTATION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-183.2(a1) reads as rewritten:

9 "(a1) Safety Inspection ~~Exception~~Exceptions. – ~~Historic vehicles, as defined in~~  
10 ~~G.S. 20-79.4(b)(55)~~The following vehicles shall not be subject to a safety inspection  
11 pursuant to this ~~Article~~Article:

12 (1) Historic vehicles, as defined in G.S. 20-79.4(b)(55).

13 (2) Buses titled to a local education agency and subject to the school bus  
14 inspection requirements specified by the State Board of Education and  
15 G.S. 115C-248(a)."

16 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
