| 6  | SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the                         |
| 7  | Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of two    |
| 8  | hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds |
| 9  | shall be used for the implementation of messages and materials for an ongoing safe    |
| 10 | Sleep Awareness campaign, which will highlight safe sleep practices to aid in the     |
| 11 | prevention of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS) and accidental                      |
| 12 | suffocation/strangulation.  |
