5	Whereas, the Legislative Commission on Global Climate Change was
6	established by S.L. 2005-442 to conduct an in-depth examination of issues related to
7	global climate change; and
8	Whereas, the Legislative Commission on Global Climate Change has met
9	regularly since its inception in pursuit of its legislative charge; and
10	Whereas, the Legislative Commission on Global Climate Change needs
11	additional time to carry out its legislative charge; Now, therefore,
12	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
13	SECTION 1. Section 1 of S.L. 2006-73 reads as rewritten:
14	"SECTION 11. Reports The Commission shall submit an interim report to the
15	General Assembly and the Environmental Review Commission no later than 15 January
16	2007 and may submit interim reports at other times at its discretion. The Commission
17	shall submit a final report, including any findings and recommendations, to the 2009
18	General Assembly and the Environmental Review Commission on or before 15 April
19	2008,1 April 2009, at which time the Commission shall terminate."
20	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
