AN ACT CONSOLIDATING THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE CUSTOMIZED TRAINING PROGRAMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 115D-5.1 reads as rewritten:

## "§ 115D-5.1. Workforce Development Programs.

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- (c) The State Board of Community Colleges shall report to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee on September 1 of each year on expenditures for the New and Expanding Industry Training Program—Customized Training Programs each fiscal year. The report shall include, for each company or individual that receives funds for the New and Expanding Industry Training Program:Customized Training Programs:
  - (1) The total amount of funds received by the company or individual;
  - (2) The amount of funds per trainee received by the company or individual;
  - (3) The amount of funds received per trainee by the community college training the trainee;
  - (4) The number of trainees trained by company and by community college; and
  - (5) The number of years the companies or individuals have been funded.
- (d) Funds available to the New and Expanding Industry Training Program for Customized Training Programs shall not revert at the end of a fiscal year but shall remain available until expended.
- (e) There is created within the North Carolina Community College System the Customized Industry Training (CIT) Program. The CIT Program shall offer programs and training services as new options for assisting existing business and industry to
