DISTRICT ATTORNEYS FOR PROSECUTORIAL DISTRICT 26.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

"(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth in the following table:

40 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
 41 Department the sum of one million four hundred eighty-three thousand thirty-five
 42 dollars (\$1,483,035) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of one million four
 43 hundred thirty-three thousand nine hundred seventy dollars (\$1,433,970) for the

- 1 2008-2009 fiscal year to establish the 15 additional assistant district attorneys
2 authorized by this act.
3 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
