5	SECTION 1. G.S. 153A-199 reads as rewritten:		
6	"§ 153A-199. Payment of assessments in full or by installments.		
7	Within 30 days after the day that notice of confirmation of the assessment roll is		
8	published, each owner of assessed property shall pay his assessment in full, unless the		
9	board of commissioners has provided that assessments may be paid in annual		
10	installments. If payment by installments is permitted, any portion of an assessment not		
11	paid within the 30-day period shall be paid in annual installments. The board shall in the		
12	assessment resolution determine whether payment may be made by annual installments		
13	and set the number of installments, which may not be more than 10.15. With respect to		
14		installment, the board may provide
