A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE TOWN  
CREEK ARTIFACT COLLECTION AND EDUCATION FACILITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources, Division of Archives and History, the sum of one million six hundred eighty-two thousand nine hundred ninety-two dollars (\$1,682,992) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to be allocated to the Friends of Town Creek Indian Mound, Inc., for the construction of the Town Creek Artifact Collection and Education Facility in Mt. Gilead. This facility will provide space for archaeological artifact curation and exhibition, classrooms, and laboratories.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
