A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE NORTH CAROLINA PARTNERSHIP FOR CHILDREN,  
INC., TO RETAIN UNEXPENDED FUNDS FOR THE 2007-2008 FISCAL YEAR  
AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Session Law 2008-107 is amended by adding a new section to  
read:

**"ALLOW SMART START TO RETAIN UNEXPENDED FUNDS**

**SECTION 10.6A.** Funds appropriated to the Department of Health and Human  
Services, Division of Child Development, for the North Carolina Partnership for  
Children, Inc., and allocated to local partnerships for the 2007-2008 fiscal year that are  
unexpended shall remain available to the North Carolina Partnership for Children, Inc.,  
to reallocate to local partnerships."

**SECTION 2.** G.S. 143B-168.15 is amended by adding a new subsection to  
read:

"(h) State funds allocated to local partnerships that are unexpended at the end of a  
fiscal year shall remain available to the North Carolina Partnership for Children, Inc., to  
reallocate to local partnerships."

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
