A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO MANCHESTER CDC, INC.,
2 HOLLYWOOD HEIGHTS COMMUNITY CLUB, INCORPORATED, SEVENTY
3 FIRST TOWNSHIP CIVIC IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION,
4 INCORPORATED, THE TIFFANY PINES COMMUNITY OUTREACH
5 CENTER, AND THE SANDHILLS FAMILY HERITAGE ASSOCIATION TO
6 SUPPORT COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES IN CUMBERLAND COUNTY.

8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

9 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Manchester
10 CDC, Inc., a nonprofit organization, the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the
11 2007-2008 fiscal year to develop cultural and recreational activities in the Manchester
12 Township of Cumberland County.

13 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Hollywood
14 Heights Community Club, Incorporated, a nonprofit organization, the sum of ten
15 thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year for community association
16 improvements.

17 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Seventy
18 First Township Civic Improvement Association, Incorporated, a nonprofit organization,
19 the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to provide civic,
20 cultural, and senior citizen activities.

21 **SECTION 4.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Tiffany Pines
22 Community Outreach Center, a nonprofit organization, the sum of five thousand dollars
23 (\$5,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year for use in providing bicycles and computers to
24 disadvantaged youth in the City of Fayetteville and surrounding areas. The operator of
25 this Center is known as the "Bicycle Man."

26 **SECTION 5.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Sandhills
27 Family Heritage Association, a nonprofit organization, the sum of fifteen thousand
28 dollars (\$15,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to assist minority landowners living in

- 1 Harnett, Cumberland, Richmond, and Moore Counties preserve their lands and protect
2 their cultural heritage.
3 **SECTION 6.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
