4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 14-415.23 reads as rewritten:

"§ 14-415.23. Statewide uniformity.

15 16 It is the intent of the General Assembly to prescribe a uniform system for the regulation of legally carrying a concealed handgun. To insure uniformity, no political subdivisions, boards, or agencies of the State nor any county, city, municipality, municipal corporation, town, township, village, nor any department or agency thereof, may enact ordinances, rules, or regulations concerning legally carrying a concealed handgun. A unit of local government may adopt an ordinance to permit the posting of a prohibition against carrying a concealed handgun, in accordance with G.S. 14-415.11(c), on local government buildings, their appurtenant premises, and parks-buildings and their appurtenant premises."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2007.
