HOUSE BILL 885

Short Title: Town of Morrisville Motor Vehicle Tax. (Local)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO PERMIT THE TOWN OF MORRISVILLE TO LEVY A MOTOR
3 VEHICLE PRIVILEGE TAX OF UP TO FIFTEEN DOLLARS FOR EACH
4 RESIDENT VEHICLE LOCATED IN THE TOWN.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** This act applies to the Town of Morrisville only.

7 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 20-97(b) reads as rewritten:

8 "(b) General Municipal Vehicle Tax. – Cities and towns may levy a tax of not
9 more than ~~five dollars (\$5.00)~~ fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per year upon any vehicle
10 resident in the city or town. The proceeds of the tax up to five dollars (\$5.00) may be
11 used for any lawful purpose. The proceeds of these taxes derived from any levy above
12 five dollars (\$5.00) and up to fifteen dollars (\$15.00) shall be used exclusively for
13 transportation-related purposes, including sidewalks."

14 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective for taxes imposed for taxable years
15 beginning on or after July 1, 2007.
