A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A NEW SALARY SCHEDULE FOR CERTIFIED PERSONNEL OF THE NORTH CAROLINA PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1.(a) Effective July 1, 2007, the following salary schedule shall be applicable to certified personnel of the public schools who are classified as "A" and "M" teachers:

SECTION 1.(b) For the 2007-2008 school year, each employee shall be placed on the appropriate salary schedule on the basis of years of experience as follows:

No employee's salary shall be reduced as a result of placement on the appropriate salary schedule and no employee shall receive less than a one thousand dollar (\$1,000) salary increase as a result of placement on the appropriate salary schedule for the 2007-2008 school year.

SECTION 1.(c) Beginning with the 2008-2009 school year, employees shall receive annual increments of one step on the appropriate salary schedule for each year of employment.

SECTION 1.(d) Enactment of this salary schedule shall not be construed to diminish or rescind additions to salary amounts provided by law for an employee's possession of an advanced certificate, earned doctorate degree, or National Board for Professional Teaching Standards certification; nor shall enactment of this salary schedule be construed to diminish or rescind rights or benefits conferred upon teachers by law, other than those which expressly refer to salary matters.

SECTION 1.(e) The State Board of Education shall adopt rules and regulations necessary to implement this section.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
