The study shall include a review of the following features of the local occupancy tax 9 10 laws: 11 (1) The maximum tax rate. 12 The authorized use of the revenue generated. (2) 13 The rentals subject to the tax. (3) **SECTION 2.** The Revenue Laws Study Committee shall report its findings 14 on this issue, including any recommendations or legislative proposals, to the 2008 15 Regular Session of the General Assembly. 16

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
