A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF JUSTICE EDUCATION BY SUPPORTING THE LAW SCHOOLS IN THE STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of six million eighty-eight thousand dollars (\$6,088,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of six million eighty-eight thousand dollars (\$6,088,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to improve the quality of justice education by allocating those funds as follows:

- (1) \$3,746,000 shall be allocated each fiscal year to the School of Law at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill for operating expenses.
- (2) \$2,342,000 shall be allocated each fiscal year to the School of Law at North Carolina Central University for operating expenses.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
