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2	AN ACT DIRECTING THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO PROVIDE AT
3	LEAST ONE TEACHER PER GRADE LEVEL FOR CERTAIN SMALL,
4	GEOGRAPHICALLY ISOLATED SCHOOLS.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. The State Board of Education shall modify its policy on the
7	allotment of additional classroom teachers to small schools when consolidation is not
8	feasible due to the geographic isolation of the school to provide for the allotment of
9	additional teachers to any such school in which the average daily membership is 110 or
10	less. In administering this policy with regard to (i) a school located in a local school
11	administrative unit in which the average daily membership is less than 1.5 per square
12	mile, (ii) a school that serves students in K-5, or (iii) a school that serves students in
13	K-8, the State Board of Education shall, at a minimum:
14	(1) Allot teachers to the geographically isolated school on the basis of one
15	classroom teacher per grade level; and
16	(2) Allot teachers to the remainder of the local school administrative unit
17	under the regular teacher allotment formula.
18	The State Board may allot additional teachers to the local school administrative unit if
19	demographic conditions warrant.
20	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.

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
