6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. G.S. 105-187.6(9) reads as rewritten:
8	"§ 105-187.6. Exemptions from highway use tax.
9	(a) Full Exemptions. – The tax imposed by this Article does not apply when a
10	certificate of title is issued as the result of a transfer of a motor vehicle:
11	
12	(9) To a volunteer fire department or volunteer rescue squad that is not
13	part of a unit of local government, has no more than two paid
14	employees, and is exempt from State income tax under
15	G.S. 105-130.11, when the motor vehicle is one of the following:
16	a. A fire truck, a pump truck, a tanker truck, or a ladder truck used
17	to suppress fire.
18	b. A four-wheel drive vehicle intended to be mounted with a water
19	tank and hose and used for forest fire fighting.
20	c. An emergency services vehicle.
21	This subdivision shall apply to a volunteer fire department or volunteer
22	rescue squad that is housed in a building or structure provided by a
23	unit of government, whether rent is charged or not.

25	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 2007.
