7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
8	SECTION 1. Chapter 136 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a		
9	new section to read:		
10	"§ 136-133.1. Outdoor advertising selective vegetation removal zone.		
11	The maximum removal area for vegetation for each sign face shall be determined as		
12	follows:		
13	<u>(1)</u>	<u>The point located on the edge of the right-of-way that is the closest</u>	
14		point to the centerline of the sign face shall be point A.	
15	(2)	The point located 200 feet down the right-of-way line in the direction	
16		of the sign viewing zone shall be point B.	
17	<u>(3)</u>	<u>The point on the edge of the pavement of the travel way that is the</u>	
18		closest to the centerline of the sign shall be point C.	
19	<u>(4</u>)	<u>The point 50 feet down the edge of the pavement in the direction of the</u>	
20		sign viewing zone from point C shall be point D.	
21	<u>(5)</u>	<u>The point 500 feet down the edge of pavement in the direction of the</u>	
22		sign viewing zone from point C shall be point E.	
23	<u>(6</u>)	<u>Lines drawn from point A to point D and from point B to point E shall</u>	
24		define the limits of the vegetation removal area."	
25	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.		

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
