A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO DIRECT THE NORTH CAROLINA SENTENCING AND POLICY

ADVISORY COMMISSION TO REVIEW AND EVALUATE THE CURRENT

STRUCTURED SENTENCING SYSTEM FOR THE PURPOSE OF

ELIMINATING MANDATORY MINIMUM SENTENCES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The North Carolina Sentencing and Policy Advisory Commission shall review and evaluate the current sentencing structure in North Carolina as set out in Chapter 15A and Chapter 90 of the General Statutes for the purpose of eliminating the requirement that a mandatory minimum sentence be imposed for any crime. The Sentencing Commission shall develop a plan to revise the sentencing structure to eliminate mandatory minimum sentences and shall provide that plan and report its recommendations on how to implement the revised structure to the 2007 General Assembly, 2008 Regular Session.

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
