A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE STATE EMPLOYEES HEALTH PLAN TO USE FUNDS TO ASSIST WITH OPERATING COSTS OF WELLNESS PILOT PROGRAMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The Executive Administrator and Board of Trustees of the State Health Plan for Teachers and State Employees may use funds available in an amount not to exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to assist with operating costs for the wellness pilot programs being operated at East Carolina University and the Cleveland County YMCA.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
