15	Assistance Authority, as appropriate, may forgive or reduce any repayment of the			
16	discount if it finds that extenuating circumstances exist that would make repayment			
17	impossible.

Contractual Conditions of Discount Tuition Rate. - Any student receiving a 5 (c)6 discount tuition rate under this section shall enter into a legal agreement with the 7 Community Colleges System Office or the State Education Assistance Authority, as appropriate, to accept employment in this State in the field of fire science for a period of 8 9 one year. The terms of the contract shall address the following: the time period within 10 which the student must satisfy the employment requirement set out by this subsection, 11 the schedule and terms for repaying the discount plus interest in the event the student does not work in this State in the field of fire science, changes in a student's academic 12 13 status and how those changes may affect the determination of whether a student is in 14 breach of the contract including a student's transfer to another institution of higher 15 education, delayed graduation, or failure to graduate, and any other terms deemed necessary or appropriate to administer the contract. The Community Colleges System 16 17 Office or State Education Assistance Authority, as appropriate, may forgive or reduce 18 any repayment of the discount if it finds that extenuating circumstances exist that would 19 make repayment impossible. 20 State Education Assistance Authority May Administer Discount Tuition Rate. (d) 21 - The State Education Assistance Authority may administer the functions regarding the 22 discount tuition rate and the execution and enforcement of contract terms for the 23 Community Colleges System Office if requested by the State Board of Community 24 Colleges to do so. The State Education Assistance Authority may also adopt rules as 25 necessary to carry out its responsibilities under this section. 26 State Board of Community Colleges to Adopt Policies Regarding Discount (e) 27 Tuition Rate. - The State Board of Community Colleges shall adopt any policies 28 necessary to implement the provisions of this section. Legislative Intent: - Community Ccolleges Shall Not Incur Revenue Loss as 29 (f)30 Result of Discount Tuition Rate. - It is the intent of the General Assembly that no community college shall incur a loss in revenue by providing a discount tuition rate 31 32 under this section; therefore, the General Assembly intends that the difference between the tuition rate and the discount tuition rate be funded by monies from the General 33 34 Fund. 35 Nothing in this section shall be construed to require volunteer firefighters to (g) 36 pay tuition for coursework taken toward a degree in fire protection technology." 37 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007, and applies to the

38 2007-2008 academic year and each subsequent academic year.
