A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO CONTINUE THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMISSION ON  
2 DROPOUT PREVENTION AND HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION, AS  
3 RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMISSION ON  
4 DROPOUT PREVENTION AND HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** Section 7.32 (f)(8) of S.L. 2007-323 reads as rewritten:

8 "(8) The Commission ~~may submit an interim report, including any~~  
9 ~~recommendations and proposed legislation, to the Joint Legislative~~  
10 ~~Education Oversight Committee and the General Assembly by May 1,~~  
11 ~~2008, and shall submit a final~~ an interim written report of its findings  
12 and recommendations on or before the convening of the 2009 Session  
13 of the General Assembly. The Commission may submit an interim  
14 report, including any recommendations and proposed legislation, to the  
15 Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee and the General  
16 Assembly by May 1, 2010, and shall submit a final written report of its  
17 findings and recommendations on or before the convening of the 2011  
18 Session of the General Assembly. All reports shall be filed with the  
19 President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of  
20 Representatives, and the Legislative Librarian. Upon filing its final  
21 report, the Commission shall terminate."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
