1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO REMOVE THE CAP ON SATELLITE ANNEXATIONS FOR THE
3 TOWN OF KENANSVILLE.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 160A-58.1(b)(5) reads as rewritten:

6 "(b) A noncontiguous area proposed for annexation must meet all of the following
7 standards:

8 ...

9 (5) The area within the proposed satellite corporate limits, when added to
10 the area within all other satellite corporate limits, may not exceed ten
11 percent (10%) of the area within the primary corporate limits of the
12 annexing city.

13 This subdivision does not apply to the Cities of Claremont,
14 Concord, Conover, Durham, Elizabeth City, Gastonia, Greenville,
15 Hickory, Kannapolis, Locust, Marion, Mount Airy, Mount Holly, New
16 Bern, Newton, Oxford, Randleman, Roanoke Rapids, Rockingham,
17 Sanford, Salisbury, Southport, Statesville, and Washington and the
18 Towns of Ahoskie, Angier, Ayden, Benson, Bladenboro, Burgaw,
19 Calabash, Catawba, Clayton, Columbia, Columbus, Cramerton,
20 Creswell, Dallas, Dobson, Four Oaks, Fuquay-Varina, Garner,
21 Godwin, Green Level, Grimesland, Holly Ridge, Holly Springs,
22 Kenansville, Kenly, Knightdale, Landis, Leland, Louisburg, Maggie
23 Valley, Maiden, Mayodan, Midland, Mocksville, Morrisville, Mount
24 Pleasant, Oak Island, Pembroke, Pine Level, Princeton, Ranlo,
25 Rolesville, Rutherfordton, Shallotte, Smithfield, Spencer, Stem,
26 Stovall, Surf City, Swansboro, Taylorsville, Troy, Wallace, Warsaw,
27 Watha, Waynesville, Weldon, Wendell, Windsor, Yadkinville, and
28 Zebulon."

29 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
