A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO PROVIDE INDIGENTS WITH FUNERAL  
2 AND BURIAL SERVICES.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the  
6 Department of Health and Human Services the sum of three million dollars  
7 (\$3,000,000) in recurring funds for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to be allocated to county  
8 Departments of Social Services to assist with the cost of funeral services for indigent  
9 residents. The allocation shall be fairly distributed upon a pro rata basis to each county  
10 based upon the numbers of residents on public assistance programs in a county. The  
11 county Departments of Social Services shall make a determination of eligibility for  
12 payment assistance, based upon readily available information, as to whether the  
13 deceased was enrolled or could have been enrolled in Medicaid, food stamp program, or  
14 other public assistance program. For deceased indigents referred to funeral homes by a  
15 county Department of Social Services or otherwise determined by a county Department  
16 of Social Services to be eligible for payment assistance, the county Department shall  
17 reimburse the funeral home for actual costs, not to exceed one thousand five hundred  
18 dollars (\$1,500) per indigent, for providing funeral, cremation, and burial services to the  
19 eligible indigent. Reimbursement shall be made pro rata and on an annual basis to  
20 funeral homes based on available funds. These funds shall not revert at the end of the  
21 fiscal year but shall remain available until expended for this purpose.

22 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
