2 AN ACT TO EXEMPT THE CITY OF DURHAM FROM CERTAIN PROVISIONS
3 OF THE GENERAL STATUTES REGARDING SOLICITATIONS IN, ON, AND
4 NEAR A PUBLIC STREET OR ROADWAY.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-175(d) reads as rewritten:

7 "(d) Local governments may enact ordinances restricting or prohibiting a person
8 from standing on any street, highway, or right-of-way excluding sidewalks while
9 soliciting, or attempting to solicit, any employment, business, or contributions from the
10 driver or occupants of any vehicle. This subsection does not permit additional
11 restrictions or prohibitions on the activities of licensees, employees, or contractors of
12 the Department of Transportation or of any municipality engaged in construction or
13 maintenance or in making traffic or engineering ~~surveys~~ surveys. ~~except as provided in~~
14 ~~subsection (e) of this section.~~"

15 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 20-175(e) is repealed.

16 **SECTION 3.** This act applies to the City of Durham only.

17 **SECTION 4.** This act is effective upon ratification.
