"(a1) Any person or persons who, having in the person's possession or	r with the use
or threatened use of any replica, article, or device which a reasonable p	person would
believe to be a firearm or other deadly weapon, whereby a reasonable personable	son under the
circumstances would believe that his or her life was endangered o	r threatened,
unlawfully takes or attempts to take personal property from another or from	n any place of
business, residence, or banking institution or any other place where there is	is a person or
persons in attendance, at any time, either day or night, or who aids or ab	oets any such
person or persons in the commission of such crime, shall be guilty of a Class	ss D felony."
