AN ACT PROVIDING THAT NO GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY OUTSIDE OF POLK
COUNTY MAY ANNEX ANY PORTION OF THAT COUNTY OR EXTEND ITS
EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION INTO POLK COUNTY.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
<b>SECTION 1.</b> Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no county or no
incorporated city, town, or village outside of Polk County may annex any territory
within Polk County or extend its extraterritorial planning jurisdiction into Polk County.
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
