6	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-137.1(b) reads as rewritten:
7	"(b) The provisions of this section shall not apply: (i) to ambulances or other
8	emergency vehicles; (ii) when the child's personal needs are being attended to; (iii) (ii)
9	if all seating positions equipped with child passenger restraint systems or seat belts are
10	occupied; or (iv)(iii) to vehicles which are not required by federal law or regulation to
11	be equipped with seat belts."
12	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
