A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REMOVE THE EXCEPTION OF ALLOWING A CHILD TO BE OUT OF A CHILD SAFETY RESTRAINT SYSTEM WHILE THE CHILD'S PERSONAL NEEDS ARE BEING ATTENDED TO. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 20-137.1(b) reads as rewritten: "(b) The provisions of this section shall not apply: (i) to ambulances or other emergency vehicles; (ii) when the child's personal needs are being attended to; (iii) (ii) if all seating positions equipped with child passenger restraint systems or seat belts are occupied; or (iv)(iii) to vehicles which are not required by federal law or regulation to be equipped with seat belts." SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
