AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUSTAIN THE BIRTH DEFECTS MONITORING PROGRAM. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to:

Continue analysis and dissemination of birth defects information for health care providers, public health programs, public officials, and the general public.
