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2	AN ACT TO ALLOW THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ENTER
3	INTO AGREEMENTS WITH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENTS TO EXPEDITE
4	CONNECTING ROADS BETWEEN AN INTERSTATE AND ANOTHER MODE
5	OF TRANSPORTATION.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. G.S. 136-66.8 reads as rewritten:
8	"§ 136-66.8. Agreements with units of local government to expedite projects.
9	(a) Agreements Authorized. – The Department of Transportation may enter into
10	agreements with units of local government for the purpose of expediting transportation
11	projects currently programmed in the Transportation Improvement Plan.Plan or on a
12	street or highway that connects an interstate highway with another mode of
13	transportation such as an international airport, international port, train terminus, or a
14	multimodal transportation facility.
15	(b) Form of Agreements. – The agreements affected by this section shall be
16	between the Department of Transportation and units of local government. The
17	agreements may authorize units of local government to construct projects scheduled in
18	the Transportation Improvement Plan more than two years from the date of the
19	agreement. The units of local government shall fund one hundred percent (100%) of the
20	project at current prices. In a future year, when the project is funded from State and
21	federal sources, the units of local government shall be reimbursed an appropriate share
22	of the funds, at the future programmed project funding amount, as identified and
23	scheduled in the Transportation Improvement Plan. If the agreement is for a connector
24	road between modes of transportation, the Department and the unit of local government
25	may determine the terms of the agreement except that units of local government shall
26	fund one hundred percent (100%) of the project at current prices. In a future year, when
27	the project is funded from State or federal sources, the units of local government shall
28	be reimbursed an appropriate share of the funds, at a funding amount not to exceed the
29	actual cost of the agreed project.

1	(c) Report The Department of Transportation shall report to the Joint
2	Legislative Transportation Oversight Committee by December 1, 2006, 2007, on any
3	agreements executed with units of local government pursuant to this section.section and
4	by December 1 each year thereafter."
5	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
